Integrate Academy – Beach House Course Etiquette & House Guidelines Policy

We want your time at the Beach House to be a positive and enjoyable experience. The Beach House offers a relaxed, retreat-style environment, but please remember that you are attending an intensive professional teacher-training course, and we ask all learners to respect the learning environment, their tutors and fellow students.

During Training Hours

Learners are expected to be present and actively engaged throughout all scheduled teaching sessions, including peer teaching, observations, group work and practical sessions.

Scheduled breaks will be provided throughout the day. Outside of these times, learners should remain with the course unless they need to use the toilet, refill water, take medication or deal with something genuinely urgent.

Please avoid taking additional personal breaks to check emails, make non-urgent phone calls or attend to work during teaching time. Missing part of a session may mean missing important course content. It can also impact another learner's experience, particularly during peer teaching and micro-teaching sessions where everyone relies on each other's participation.

If you do need to step away unexpectedly, please let your tutor know.

Respecting Peer Teaching

Peer teaching and micro-teaching are an important part of your training.

When another learner is teaching, we ask that you give them the same attention, participation and respect that you would expect when it is your turn to teach.

Please remain present and engaged throughout these sessions unless there is an urgent reason to leave.

Food & Drinks

Water bottles are welcome in the training space.

To protect the equipment and maintain a professional training environment, please do not eat whilst sitting or lying on the Reformers. Food should be enjoyed in the designated kitchen, dining or break areas during scheduled breaks.

Beach House Facilities

We love being able to offer training in such a unique setting.

The swimming and sauna facilities form part of the residential experience for learners who have booked accommodation at the Beach House. They are not included for day students attending the course.

For residential learners, these facilities should be enjoyed outside scheduled teaching hours and during appropriate free time rather than during course sessions.

Outdoor Areas

You're very welcome to enjoy the outdoor spaces during scheduled breaks.

During teaching hours, however, learners are expected to participate fully in the course rather than using the gardens or outdoor areas for sunbathing or leisure.

Tea, Coffee & Refreshments

Tea and coffee facilities are available during scheduled breaks.

Please avoid leaving teaching sessions to make drinks unless necessary, as this can be distracting and may mean missing important course content.

Phones, Emails & Work

We understand that everyone has commitments outside of the course.

Where possible, phones should be kept on silent and emails, messages and non-urgent calls dealt with during scheduled breaks.

We completely understand that genuine emergencies happen. If you need to take an urgent call or step away, simply let your tutor know.

A Shared Learning Environment

The Beach House experience works best when everyone contributes to creating a supportive, professional and respectful learning environment.

Your tutor will keep the course running to schedule and ensure regular breaks are provided. In return, we ask learners to arrive on time, participate fully and respect the time and learning experience of everyone in the group.
